

DONATE A TOY AND BRING A SMILE TO A KID'S FACE





IS YOUR HOME READY FOR WINTER? 5 SIMPLE WAYS TO PROTECT YOUR HOME

1. Keep snow away from your home's foundation


Snow is harmful for your home's structure. One simple way to avoid deterioration of your home's foundation and expensive repairs is to stop snow or water from collecting around the base of your house. Focus on areas that are prone to snow accumulation such as basement windows and concrete staircases. You can also hire professionals to do the job.

2. Clear snow and ice from external vents

Although clogged vents can cause damage to your property, the real threat is actually to your heating and cooling systems. Clogged vents create extra pressure inside which can lead to accumulation of moisture and if not taken proper care can infect your home with mold or rot in wood structures. So make sure your vents are not snow clogged.

3. Seal doors and windows

Make sure your home is ready to handle the cold. Carefully inspect your doors and windows for gaps and areas that may let in a draft. Use weatherstripping or caulk to seal them up, or consider replacing the windows or doors if the risk is high.



4. Prevent pipes from freezing

Most of the time your water pipes will not freeze. However. if it flows through any part of the house that isn't heated, or if the heating system fails, the water inside can convert to ice. When water in a pipe freezes, it expands and exerts pressure on both metal and plastic pipes which can burst. To prevent this make sure your heating stays on and keep your faucet dripping.

5. Bring the outdoors inside

Be sure to move in all outdoor furniture and equipment (BBQ grill, lawn mowers) to indoor storage and bring inside any planters you'd like to save through the season. Also, make sure to turn off all sprinkle systems as well as unplug garden hoses to prevent them getting snow clogged rendering them useless.
